2003 – Homestead Begins

Stephen Stoltzfus and his brother founded Homestead Structures as a side business to supplement the dairy farm. We converted a 3200 sq. ft. equipment shed into a manufacturing facility and built our first shed.

2004 – Dealers Welcomed

We signed up our first Dealers and hired our first workers.

2005 – Growing the Business

We hired our first business coach, attended our first wholesale show, set a long-term revenue goal, and hit that goal by the end of the year.

2006 – Changes

Steve took on full ownership of Homestead, added six to eight more workers, and designed our first traditional pool house gazebo.

2007 – Getting Lean

We implemented lean manufacturing principles in our shop.

2008 – A Banner Year

We introduced the Garden Belle and Belle Poolside Bar at a Wholesale Show. Dealers loved them, and this was a banner year for Homestead.

2009 – Selling Smarter

We received our first modern pool house order which would later become our Siesta model. We also began training with the Sandler Selling System[®].

2010 – Establishing Our Niche

We wanted to become the best in pool houses, so we invested in photography, built a website, and began building the retail side of Homestead.

2011 – The Siesta Poolside Bar

The Siesta was the first standard pool house model we introduced to break into more modern designs.

2012 – Expansion

We expanded our shop facilities to 6400 sq. ft., and implemented MethodCRM, a web-based software that brought together our sales data, customer history, finances, and more to improve efficiency.

2012 - 2014 – The Avalon, Heritage & Wellington

Over a two-year period we designed three additional standard pool houses to offer our customers, moving away from more traditional "gazebo-like" pool houses and into modern designs.













2014 – Embracing the Web

We launched a big website redesign project, fully embracing the internet to find more customers and promote our brand to a whole new audience.

2015 – 2016 – Hiring the Right People

We invested in several high-level positions, hiring a fulltime in-house marketing manager, a sales director, and several key hires in the operations department.

2017 – The Whole Package

We began offering fully finished interiors, including bathrooms, kitchens, bedrooms, fireplaces and more, plus outdoor kitchen and bars.

2018 – Crafting our Showroom

We designed and began upgrading our outdoor showroom area, adding a completely custom Avalon as our first permanent structure.

2019 – Introducing EOS

To continue growing our business, we implemented EOS, a business operating system for growth. We also expanded our outside workspace by 8,000 sq. ft.

2020 – New Office Space

Our bank barn underwent complete renovation, adding a full office, lunchroom, conference room, event space/ gym area.

2021 – Equipment Upgrades

We made a large investment in equipment and building upgrades to keep up with our growing business.

2022 – Outdoor Showroom Expansion

We completed the expansion of our outdoor showroom to inspire our clients, and give them an up-close look at the quality of a Homestead building.

2023 – Homestead Turns 20
